Frenchman Valley Coop Announces Grain Management Transition

(Imperial, NE) December 22, 2016: On December 22, 2016 the Frenchman Valley Farmers Cooperative, Inc. (FVC) CEO, Doug Ohlson announced the transition of three key grain personnel.
