



Part-Time Truck Driver

Job Description:

Responsible for accurate and timely delivery of wean pigs to and from the appropriate sites. Principal activities include, but are not limited to:

- Safe and accurate delivery of pigs to sow, nursery, finish or wean to finish site as designated on the daily truck schedules
- Following directions, meeting deadlines and adhering to daily schedules.
- Complying with all related environmental and transportation standards, laws and guidelines.
- Vehicle Care and Maintenance:
- Responsible for washing trucks as scheduled and maintaining clean vehicles.
- Responsible for completing a vehicle inspection prior to the shift and reporting any repairs needed to be made
- Responsible for the care and inventory of all tools and equipment assigned to the driving unit.

Other/Misc:

- Assist in other areas of the farm as requested
- Responsible for keeping accurate, easy-to-read records including log books, pigs delivered to farm sites, trip reports, vehicle inspection sheet, etc.
- Help maintain cleanliness, neatness and safety of work area and trucks
- 15-20 hours per week Tuesday-Thursday
- Performing all other activities and responsibilities as defined by upper management

Required skills/experience:

*1 to 2 years experience driving semi is required. A current and valid driver's license is required with a clean driving record. No Commercial Drivers License (CDL) is required for this position. In addition effective problem solving, multitasking, communication and interpersonal skills are required. Individual must be cooperative, responsible, reliable, motivated, able to work as a team, able to work well with little supervision and possess the ability to work in a fast paced environment.

Individuals must be capable of walking, stooping, bending, performing repetitive motions and lifting a minimum of 50 pounds with reasonable accommodation.
