Weather Viewer

In the Weather Viewer, the data you need is customizable.

Weather

Access Layers

1. Choose the Layers Menu.
2. Slide over one of the layer groupings.
3. To view a layer, select the checkbox in front of the layer name.

Layers

Selected layers are listed in Layer Settings.

Layer Settings

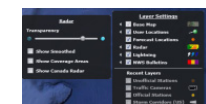
Deselect a layer to remove it from the map. The listing will be moved to the recently viewed section where it may be easily accessed. By design, some layers are mutually exclusive.

Layers may have additional options which are found by accessing the arrow to the left of the layer. Layer legends are found to the right of the layer.

Animate Layers

Some layers may be animated. Select the Play icon to start an animation loop. Modify settings under the animation preferences arrow.



Layer Details

Most layers have additional information available. Simply hover, tap or click on the map to view this information.

Alerting

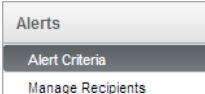
Under the Settings

Menu select criteria which when exceeded will generate an alert and cause the View Alerts icon to flash. An audible alarm may also be sounded on your desktop.



Alert Criteria

It is advisable to set the alert criteria for your default location first, as locations created afterward will automatically use the same criteria. Don't forget to configure recipients if you want to receive the alert remotely.

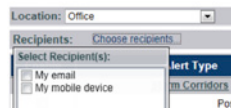


1. Under Alerts select Alert Criteria.
2. Choose a location. Roaming locations are used in SmartPhone.
3. Enable your alert criteria for each location. Lightning and PrecipTimer® settings are universal.
4. Save your changes.

Alert criteria may be edited at any time.

Remote Alerting

Mobile devices (text message), email or desktops can all be set as recipients to receive alerts generated by your criteria. The number of recipients is unlimited and group addresses may be used.



1. Select Manage Recipients.
2. Choose New. Name the device using the Recipient field.

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3. Pick the device type and complete the remaining fields.
4. Save your changes.
5. In the Alert Criteria screen add the recipient to one or more locations.
