

The following requirements are to be followed for trailers bringing grains to ZFS Ithaca, which are in addition to the grading and foreign material requirements that are outlined within the discount schedule.

Cleaning requirements (wash and sweep) are based on the prior load.

Wash with ticket (must include header with wash station name, address and phone number, date of wash and trailer ID) for trailer if the prior load contained:

Products/commodities containing prohibited material or restricted use proteins as defined in 21 CFR 589,2000 and 589,2001*

Medicated feed

Chemicals or fertilizers

Treated seeds

Sweep is allowed for:

Wood Salt Rocks Sand

Metal Untreated Grains
