

# Refinery Operator

## Summary

This position operates equipment for the seed preparation and crush, refinery, and load out process areas of an oil seed crushing plant. The primary function of this position is to ensure that these processes are operated and controlled in a safe and efficient manner in compliance with government regulations and Company standards.

## Job Requirements

### Primary Responsibilities/Essential Functions:

- Operates processing equipment and completes and logs regular checks of equipment to ensure that standard operating procedures are followed, Company standards are met, and plant efficiencies are optimized.
- Work in an organized, safe, and clean manner, ensuring work area is kept clean and free from all safety hazards.
- Responds to equipment issues or alarms; investigates and initiates resolution.
- Ensures compliance with Company safety rules and wears proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs) as required in fulfillment of assigned responsibilities.
- Conducts “in process” quality control tests, enters data into the electronic data system and operates the HMI in the plant.
- Analyzes process data to optimize plant efficiencies and product quality.

- All other duties as assigned.

**Experience:** Candidates must have a minimum of 4 years of experience in an industrial environment with a high school diploma or 1 year of experience in an industrial environment with a technical degree.
